(c) To educate the public on difficult subjects often experienced by young people through public information comics that give a young persons perspective on subjects such as: transitioning from primary to secondary school, childhood bereavement or living in care homes.



**Independent Examiners Report to the Trustees of Comics Youth SCIO
Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation SC051377**

I report on the accounts of the Charity for the year ended 30th November 2022, which are set out on the accompanying pages.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) 2005 Act and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. Independent examiner's statement


